Roles

<u>ROLE</u>	<u>HOW MANY</u>	<u>FUNCTION AT THE EVENT</u>
Reviewers	10	Review the teams' models and Show Me Posters, then collaborate with other Reviewers to assign awards to all teams.
Reviewer Advisor	1	Responsible for managing and training Reviewers for the event and ensuring they are properly prepared. Ensures that the Reviewers have supplies, are fed, and are supported throughout event day as appropriate.
Emcee	1	Announcer for the day. Conducts opening and closing ceremonies and provides comments and updates throughout the day. A Script will be provided!
Traffic Control/Directors	2	Assist teams with load in/load out. Assist with directions when necessary for the event.
Registration Table	2	Check teams in as they arrive, collect Consent and Release forms, distribute team packets and programs.
Award Coordinator	1	Organizes team awards and physically hands them to sponsors to present to teams.
Event Photographer	1	Takes pictures and snapshots of the event.
Floater	1	Assist where necessary during the expo.

Volunteer positions do not require a technical background.
